All areas of design and production and management are included. Productions that were mounted from Fall 2008- Fall 2009 at the students school are eligible.

This year there are three student registrations for the 2008 USITT Conference in Kansas City that will be awarded to the participants. The judging will be done at the Job Fair on January 16, 2010 at CSUF by a jury of section officers encompassing a range of functions.

The display and judging criteria will be the same as is used in the Kennedy Center American College Theater Festival (<http://www.kennedy-center.org/education/actf/actfbarb.html>). This will also provide the students the opportunity to do a test run if they are taking part in KCACTF or URTA this year or want to in the future.
